
Dear children,

Let's go to the park.

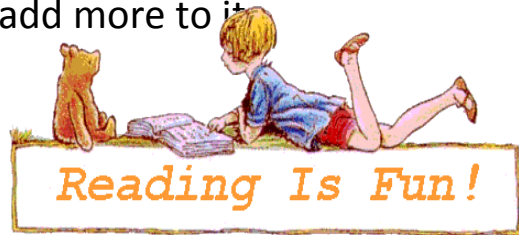

## ACTIVITY

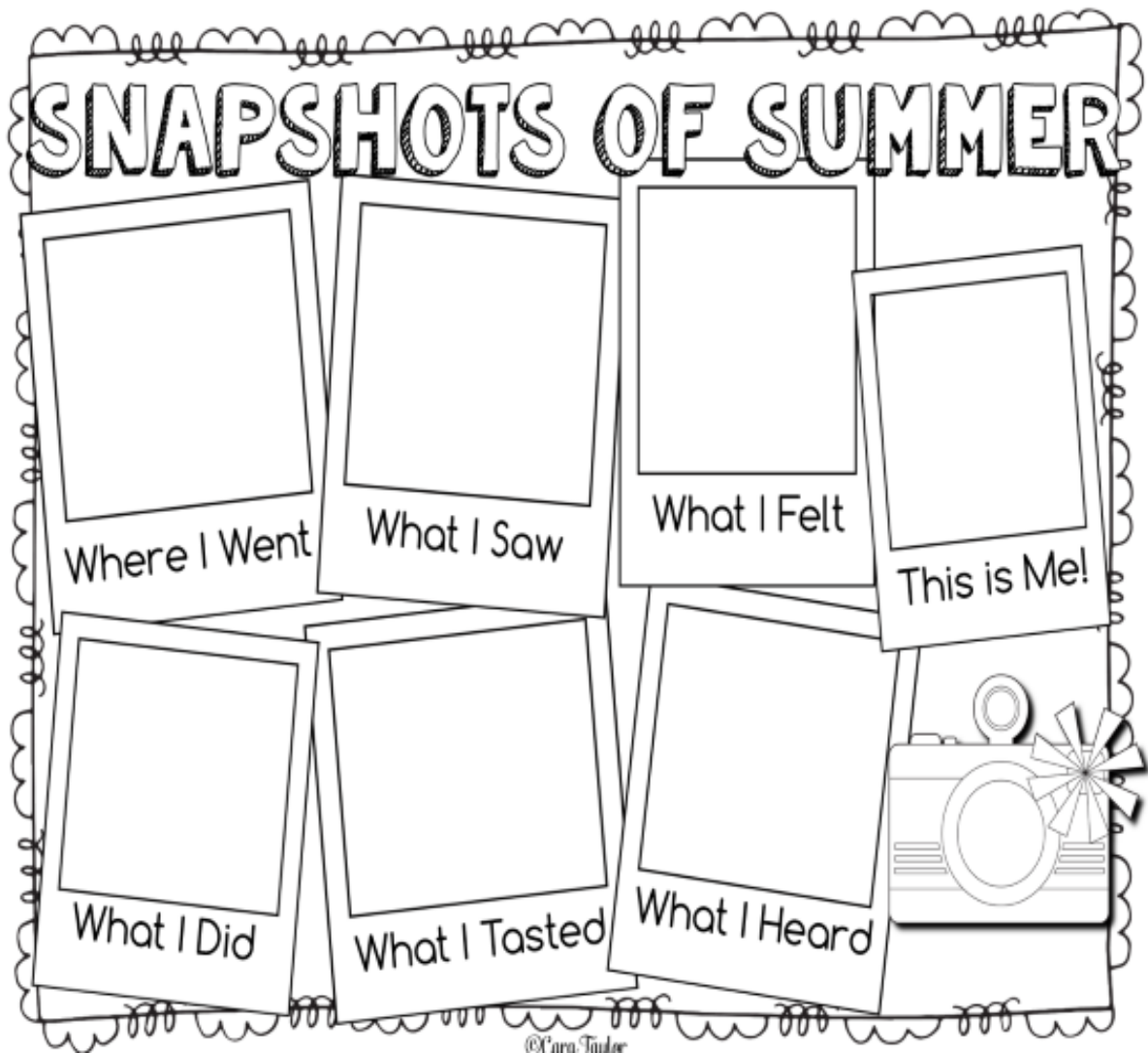
### KNOW YOUR CITY BETTER
