

ROAD SAFETY-TRAVEL SAFE-REACH SUCCESS!!!

We know that major part of our lives is spent on the roads because travelling is essential to progress, growth and survival. It is therefore an unavoidable and essential part of our lives which demands safety and security while it is undertaken. As part of the advocacy campaign for Road Safety, "ROAD SAFETY WEEK" is observed throughout the country every year in the month of January. This year the theme for the road safety week is, "ROAD SAFETY- TIME FOR ACTION."



As per the guidelines of C.B.S.E. that also took up the theme, the D.A.V. Public School, East of Loni Road, contributed to the cause by taking up various activities to promote the concept as follows:-



On 7.5.2016, the students of classes X went out to the neighbourhoods areas on a rally, to sensitize the local people about the road safety and its importance and carried placards with messages written on them to make people more aware.

The students in the rally interacted with the pedestrians and people who were not using helmets, people using mobiles while driving, people without seat belts, people who overloaded their

vehicles by tripling and auto rickshaws that were overloaded with people and commodities. Students made these people more aware of the importance of the zebra crossing and other do's and don'ts about road safety and safe travelling. To make the message of safety on roads go widespread, they distributed gifts among these people, like calendar, pen stands, and books on traffic rules with traffic symbols.



The students also interacted and communicated with the traffic police about the kinds of problems they have to face on duties. This made our students more aware and alert about the measures required for safety and security while travelling on the roads.

On 6.5.16, a quiz programme on the theme of road safety was organized in the school, in which the students of class X and VIII participated enthusiastically and the winners were given away books as rewards by students.

Students were also shown a video on traffic rules on Youtube. The whole week long awareness programme successfully sent across the message that 'ROAD SAFETY IS NOT A SLOGAN, IT IS A WAY TO LIVE LIFE.'
