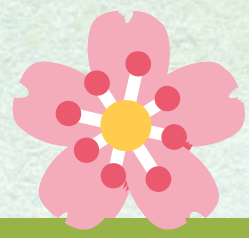

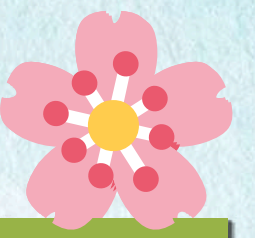

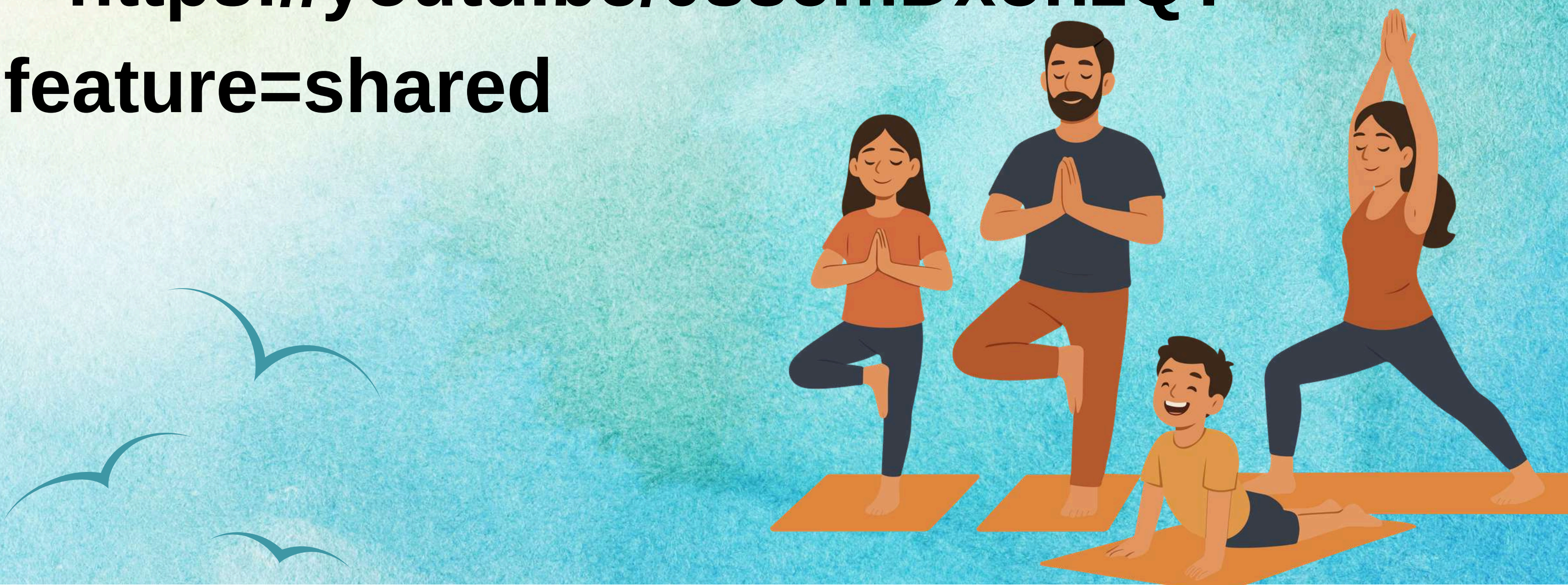
INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY(21-6-2026)

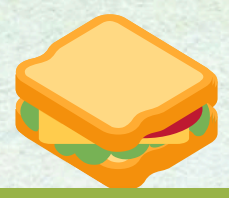
