# “Sound it, Build it, Solve it!” – My CVC Word Puzzle Game

Instructions for Parents:

## Materials Needed

- White or pastel-colored sheet
- Cardboard sheet (cut to A5 size)
- Scissors
- Glue
- Crayons/Sketch pens
- Pictures of simple CVC words (e.g., cat, pin, jug, bat)



## Steps to Create the Puzzle:

- Choose 3–4 simple CVC words (based on the child’s level).
- Write each word in bold, large letters and draw or paste a matching picture beside
- Paste the sheet onto a cardboard base to make it sturdy.
- Cut the word into three puzzle pieces (one for each letter), just like a jigsaw puzzle.
- You can also use zigzag or wavy lines to make cutting fun!
- Mix up the letters and let your child put them back together by sounding out the word.

## Optional Twist:

Write just the ending (e.g., -at) and let the child try to find the correct beginning sound using picture clues.

## Vowel-wise Roll Number Distribution:

- a vowel – Roll No. 1 to 9
- e vowel – Roll No. 10 to 18
- i vowel – Roll No. 19 to 27
- o vowel – Roll No. 28 to 35
- u vowel – Roll No. 36 to 43

- Use 1 A4 pastel sheet to make 4 flashcards.
- 2 flashcards with 2-letter words (e.g., मट, रस).

- Help your child practice reading daily.

  - Paste the photographs neatly and decorate the collage with drawings, stickers, or paper cut-outs related to summer (sun, trees, water, ice cream, etc.).
- 3. Learn to Speak a Few Lines:**
  - Encourage your child to learn and speak 2–3 simple lines about their collage.
  - For example: “This is my trip to the zoo. I saw animals and ate ice cream. I was very happy!”
- 4. Add Child’s Name:**
  - Write the child’s name and class neatly at the bottom of the collage.


# “ABC Yoga Day – Bend, Breathe, and Learn!”
